



Campus Security Timely Warning Notice Policy

In accordance with the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990 and its amendments, this policy is established with the intent of providing guidance for the release and dissemination of information to the university community on certain serious crimes that represent a foreseeable threat to students and personnel. The Timely Notification Committee will review serious crime incidents that may impact the safety of students and personnel and make appropriate notification to the university community through news media, crime bulletins, email, or other appropriate means.
