

# **Campus Fire Safety Act Policy**

As part of its commitment to providing "an environment . . . sustained by those moral virtues which characterize the life and teachings of the Son of God" (<u>BYU Mission Statement</u>), the university strives to create an on-campus housing environment that is safe and adheres to all federal campus safety laws, including the Disclosure of Fire Safety Standards and Measures (Campus Fire Safety Act), 20 U.S.C. § 1092(i).

### No Smoking or Open Flames in On-Campus Housing

The university prohibits smoking and open flames in on-campus housing. The university also regulates portable electrical appliances as described in the <u>Campus Fire Safety Act Procedures</u>.

## Procedures to Follow in Case of a Fire

The university's <u>Campus Fire Safety Act Procedures</u> detail how an on-campus resident or an employee should respond to a fire that they create or encounter and what to do in response to a fire alarm.

### Fire Safety Education and Training Programs

The university offers fire safety education and training programs to all students living in oncampus housing as described in the <u>Campus Fire Safety Act Procedures</u>.

### **Federal Law Controls**

If discrepancies exist between federal law and this policy or the <u>Campus Fire Safety Act</u> <u>Procedures</u>, federal law controls.
